

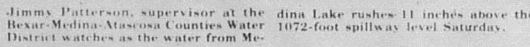

night. It was afraid there might have been an accident. That's when I called Jack Williams," she said.

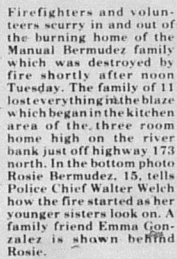

Bandera County youngsters will vie for special awards and money when they present over 130 hiked goods and almost 200 animals at the 51st annual Bandera County Junior Livestock Show to be held at Mansfield Park Jan. 8, 9 and 10.

Animals will start driving at 10 a.m. on Jan. 8 and must be in line by 10:30 a.m. Fair and Homecoming Projects by noon.

Judging will begin at 1:30 p.m. and will begin to begin that afternoon at 1 p.m. followed by dairy cattle judging at 1 p.m. and rabbit judging at 1 p.m.

Judging of market hogs will open activities on Jan. 9 at 9 a.m. and will continue with registered sheep and commercial sheep at 10 a.m. and afternoon judging will begin at 10 a.m. with beefs followed by commercial beefs, steers and lambs.

On Saturday boxed goods will begin arriving at 8 a.m. with the sheepmanship Contest and judging at 9 a.m. At 10:30 a.m. the livestock show will be announced.

Farm Mechanics Projects will be judged at 10 a.m.

Awards will be announced at 1 p.m. Saturday followed by the final at the three day show at 1:30 p.m. the livestock auction in the afternoon.

Only youngsters enrolled in 4-H Clubs, Future Farmers of America or Vocational Agriculture before Oct. 1, 1966 that live and attend first through 12th grades in Bandera (United) are eligible to participate in the livestock show.

Participants in the banderita contest must be enrolled in 10th, Future Homemakers of America or Vocational Homelike (United) in Bandera County Schools.

The fire broke out in the area of a water heater.

"I was watching television when my aunt said: 'there's a fire call for help.'" 15-year-old Rose Bermudez said. "Then we came outside."

The five girls—Rose, 15; Helga, 7; Pat, 6; Juli, 5; and Ester, 3—were all asleep when the alarm rang from the burning three-room frame home.

"It was so comforting to see another while waiting for the firemen," Rose said.

Their aunt and several volunteers that saw the smoke from Highway 173 tried to fight the fire until the firemen arrived. The first truck from Banderá arrived.

Chief Deputy Ken Mingorodado said he would take the first children's mother Ester of the fire

She was working at Purple Hills Nursing Home at the time and they, their father, Manuel Bermudez and her mother, Dolores, and brother Wharton, Duck area Brother Manuel 16, was working with his father and Eleazar, 13, had gone to his father's house earlier in the day.

The aunt and her husband Juan also lived in the house. She is now 80 years old and lives in Ocala.

"Apparently the fire started in the kitchen area and spread to the living room," she said. The firemen were unable to save any of the furniture, possessions, clothing or shoes. "Police Chief W. J. Williams said,

"I don't know where we'll go. Rosie said as she hugged a small puppy, 'I'll take you home.'"

She said tears ran from her cheeks. Three-year-old Ester hugged her around the legs.

"A small spotted puppy jumped playfully around Joli and Pat as they watched the firemen spray more water into the flames of the fire burning in the kitchen."

Clothing, food and cash for the family may be left at Purple Hills Manor nursing home.

Tommy Adams, emergency management coordinator for Handera County, was among the ten firefighters with the Handera fire truck. The truck had badly burned and charred around the stove," he said. "There was some clothing scattered near the stove."

"We've been having trouble with the hot water tank. When it got hot, we unplugged it." Ronnie told us. "We saw smoke coming from it."

"We sent both trucks," Adams said. "We refilled them both and they left. They had about 3,000 gallons of water to assist us. The crew (VPD) was coming to pipe us, but we told them to go back, as we had the fire under control," he said.

At press time friends of the Bermudez family were trying to locate a place for them to live temporarily.

There are non-perishable foods and cash donations available at Purple Hills. Betty Ball, director of Purple Hills said, "The employees here are trying to do what we can to help them." "We don't have space for furniture or large items, here," she said.

"Those wishing to donate appliances, furniture, and large items can call us and tell us what they have. We will be in contact. When housing is arranged for the family, we can arrange for delivery of the items." The number of Purple Hills is 787-777-1111.
